Excellent drainage is a must. Choose site that allows water movement away from roots, prepare 1' deep 2-3' hole, Mix 50% crushed rock (such as chicken grit) with soil ending with a somewhat mounded site. Best planted in spring or early summer to allow time for establishment before winter. Zone 7
