They will germinate during the winter and fower in May and ealry June and then reseed. 2-3' tall, full sun. Jason's family has been growing these for over 30 years. For best results mix the content of this pacakge with one cup of sand or slight moist potting soil and scatter over 10 x 10 foot area in November or December. They can be sown on the top of a mulched area or on bare soil. Do not cover seed but rack
