The UT Gardens, Jackson, is holding its amaryllis bulb sale on Tuesday, November 12th from noon to 6:00PM. Members of the UT Gardens are invited to a pre-sale on Monday, November 11th from noon to 3:00pm. If you are not a member you can become one on the 11th and shop.

We have 23 different kinds of amaryllis for a total of over 500 bulbs for this sale. Most bulbs will be 13-14 inches in circumference. Bulbs that size often produce three flowering stalks and sometimes four. They will be \$22.00 each, including tax. Small bags of potting soil will be \$3.00. We will also have conifers, trees and other bulbs. Cash or check preferred.
